The right PPE (high-vis, steel caps, hard hat etc.)	
Any required tools or trade licences

Copies of your ID (physical and digital)	

Be early, always 03.

Arriving 10-15 minutes early shows you're serious and reliable. Plan your route the day before, especially if it's a new site or remote location. If you hit traffic or run into issues, call ahead and let someone know.



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Know the safety protocols

Safety isn't a tick box, it's a mindset.

Read any induction material in advance and take it seriously. Ask questions if something's unclear. Every site is different, but one thing's the same: your safety comes first.

Bring the right attitude

05.

Skills matter, but attitude gets you rebooked.

Be respectful, positive, and ready to work hard. Keep your phone away unless it's part of the job, and show initiative. Your supervisors will notice.

Stay connected

06.

Make sure your phone is charged and that we have your up-to-date contact details. If something changes (you're sick, stuck, or confused), call us. We're here to back you.
